

The Brumley-GRAD Scholarship “Cheat” Sheet

If you are a new Brumley-GRAD Scholar enrolling in school for the first time

- New Scholar Profile Form
- The *Acknowledgement of Receipt of Scholarship Policies Form* of the **Brumley-GRAD Scholar Policies and Procedures**
- Acceptance letter (only your first academic term enrolled)
- Class schedule (reflecting full-time status)

If you are a returning Brumley-GRAD Scholar attending the same college/university as the previous term

- Returning Scholar Profile Form (if any directory information has changed)
- Unofficial Transcript (Fall term only unless requested by the Scholarship Committee)
- Class schedule

If you are a returning Brumley-GRAD Scholar transferring to another college/university

- Returning Scholar Profile Form
- Unofficial transcript from current college/university
- Acceptance letter to new college/university
- Class schedule from new college/university

If you are appealing for reinstatement of your Brumley-GRAD Scholarship

- Appeal Form
- Business-formatted letter stating your reason for appeal
- Supporting documentation (if applicable)

If you are not enrolling in an eligible college/university the fall term immediately following your high school graduation or if you are not enrolled in college for any academic term (with the exception of the summer term)

- Administrative Deferment Form
- Supporting documentation if applicable

If you wish to have a third party (parent, guardian, etc.) have access to your educational records through our office

- FERPA Form

All information must be submitted by the deadlines outlined per academic term in the Brumley-GRAD Scholarship Policies and Procedures, using the appropriate submission form.
